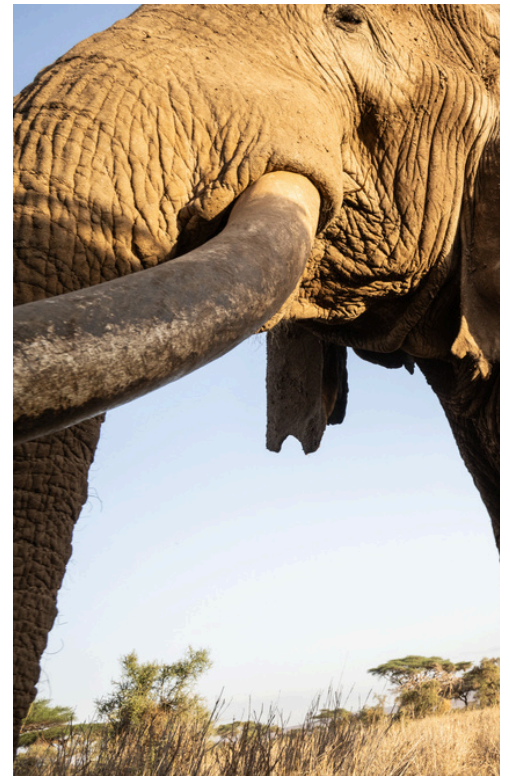

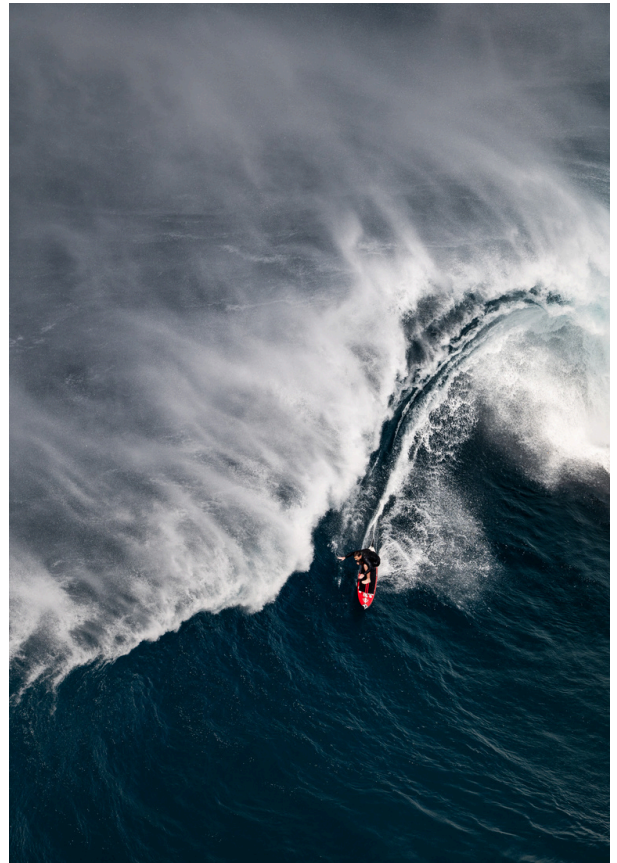

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# EMILY MCCULLISS

Now, I curate rare expeditions that reflect my belief in nature as our greatest teacher of ourselves. We meet who we are capable of by being in environments where there is no choice. My intimate journeys—whether tracking snow leopards across Mongolia's rugged terrain or swimming alongside majestic marine predators—are designed by curiosity, asking big questions, and reframing what is possible. I bridge worlds to create experiences that reveal not just extraordinary places, but unexpected dimensions of yourself.

Each expedition I lead is an invitation to step beyond the boundaries of conventional travel into a space where authentic connection—with nature, with others, and with yourself—becomes possible. My greatest satisfaction comes from witnessing the subtle transformations that occur when someone encounters something truly extraordinary: the shift in perspective, the quiet recognition of capability, the awakening of dormant questions. These are the souvenirs that matter, the ones that continue to reveal their value long after you've returned home.

My journey began at thirteen when I left home to help launch an international traveling school, discovering early that conventional paths rarely lead to extraordinary revelations. From living out of a hammock in Costa Rica for surf locations to swimming with whale sharks in Australia, I've consistently chosen experiences over expectations.
